## ART.1 COMPETITION FORMULA

1.1 The Golf Amateurs Open Rome takes place from Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> April to Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

22<sup>nd</sup> April 1st round: (18 holes) Parco di Roma Golf Club  
23<sup>rd</sup> April 2nd round: (18 holes) National Golf Club  
24<sup>th</sup> April 3rd round: (18 holes) Terre dei Consoli Golf Club

1.2 The competition is played over a distance of 54 holes (2 valid results out of 3), Maximum Result formula at hcp (see appendix).

Players will have the opportunity to play even just two days of the Tournament, at their choice. In this case they will not be able to discard the worst result and both laps will be valid for the final classification.

1.3 GAO Roma is played in 3 categories: up to 10.4 (lim); from 10.5 to 20.4 (lim); from 20.5 onwards.

### 1.4 Awards:

GAO 54 Holes: first absolute gross - first 3 absolute net results by category

1.5 In the event of a tie, the rules established by the R&A and the Italian Golf Federation will be applied.

1.6 for each round of the tournament, a prize pool will be awarded to the top 15 players in each category.

The jackpot tables are available on the [wegolfersworldtour](http://wegolfersworldtour.com) website and the complete rules on the [wegolfers.net](http://wegolfers.net) and [wegolfers.org](http://wegolfers.org) website. To get the jackpot the player must be in possession of an active WGWT Card

## ART.2 REGISTRATION

2.1 The registration fee for participation in the complete event including dinner is set at €290.

There are reduced rates for participation in two days and rates with the exclusion of dinner. These rates are visible in the event registration form.

Wegolfers Around will create packages including accommodation that will have priority in the event registration lists.

2.2 Entries close at 24.00 (midnight) on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

2.3 Entries can be completed on the Tournament website [www.amateursopen.com](http://www.amateursopen.com)

**FOR FOREIGN PLAYERS ONLY:** the player must send and deliver the HCP certification to the acceptance desk, which must be stamped and signed by the sporting authorities of their own country.

### 2.4 Redundancy and waiting list

The maximum number of subscribers is fixed at 72.

In the event of an excess of members, the principle of priority followed is as follows:

- registration by purchasing Wegolfers Around packages
- the date and time of registration.

Excess members are placed on a waiting list.

2.5 Telephone and/or fax registrations will not be accepted.

2.6 Under no circumstances will the entry fee be refunded unless a player withdraws before the closing date and time.

2.7 All entries are subject to the approval of the GAO Committee, which therefore reserves the right to refuse entry without giving any reason. The decision of the Committee will be final.

### **ART.3 CANCELLATIONS**

3.1 Until the closing date, registrations must be sent by email to [info@wegolfers.com](mailto:info@wegolfers.com)

3.2 After this date, they must be communicated by email to [info@wegolfers.com](mailto:info@wegolfers.com) and by telephone at +39 392 0057253

Re-crediting of the registration fee is permitted only in the cases relating to points 2.6 and 2.7 and in the event of cancellation of the Tournament due to force majeure.

### **ART.4 ELIGIBILITY**

The Championship is open to all golf players in good standing with the status of amateur and with the sports justice of the Federation to which they belong.

### **ART.5 NUMBER OF ENROLLMENTS**

Maximum number of participants in the 72 Tournament, divided as follows:

Category 1: 24 players

Category 2: 24 players

Category 3: 24 players

The Committee reserves the right to make changes to this maximum number by checking the registration requests received.

### **ART.6 RULES OF GOLF**

The Tournament is played in accordance with the R&A approved rules of golf and the local rules of the host clubs. All participants are advised to review these additional local rules.

### **ART.7 CLOTHING**

The use of shorts, jeans and collarless shirts by competitors is not permitted during the competition.

### **ART.8 REGISTRATION**

Competitors must register at the organizational desk on the morning of the first lap of the race, before departure.

Failure to register during the specified time period will result in immediate removal of the player from the Tournament unless extenuating circumstances can be proven.

## ART.9 PRACTICE

The practice rounds in the days prior to Saturday 22 April 2023 can be booked, compatibly with availability, by email at info@wegolfers.com or by telephone at +39 392 0057253. The green fee is communicated directly when booking the practice round .

## ART.10 CADDIES AND ELECTRIC TROLLEYS

10.1 During the laps it is allowed to have a caddy.

10.2 Electric trolleys and golf carts: the use of electric trolleys and golf carts is permitted and must be booked through the Wegolfers staff. Golf cars are RESERVED ONLY to players participating in the Tournament.

## ART.11 SCORE DELIVERY

An area (Recording Area) located near the club house and visible to all players is delimited. Players **MUST** check their scores in this area, in the presence of the Committee members. The Recording Area must be reached without delay after the completion of the eighteenth hole. The result will be considered official after the score card has been checked and signed and after the player leaves the Recording Area.

## ART.12 TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE

A Tournament Committee is set up made up of - Marco Foi, Valentina De Simoni and Vincenzo Mora. The Tournament Committee has the right to modify these regulations in order to improve the experience for all participants.

## Appendix

Maximum result: the player must mark the strokes played on the scorecard. The result of a single hole cannot be more than four strokes over the par of the hole.

The match is strokes, there should be no X marked on the score.

If the player fails to play the hole or exceeds the maximum result of four strokes over par, he must mark these results on the scorecard:

Par three: 7

Par four: 8

Par five: 9
